Selection Criteria

* Must be a student attending a school in York Region

* Must be graduating high school or equivalent in June 2022 and attending an accredited Canadian post-secondary institution (College/University) in September 2022/January 2023 on a full-time basis

* Candidate must have demonstrated leadership towards the goals of equity, inclusion and social justice in one of the following areas: ability, age, culture, gender, gender identity, language, race, religion, sexual orientation, socio-economic status through community engagement or employment.

*Candidate must list any significant contributions made to the community throughout their years as a secondary school student.

How to Apply

Complete the application Package

- Candidate must submit a 600-800 word written statement that describes their motivations in working to achieve equity, inclusion and/or social justice goals
- Include two letters of recommendation from either: a school staff member, a family, a community organization or community member





- Candidate will consent to the publication of their name and image by the York Regional Police, if selected as a Youth Achievement Awards recipient. Candidate must list any extra-curricular contributions made throughout their years as a secondary school student.
- Candidate must list any significant contributions made to the community throughout their years as a secondary school student.
